A Crash Course in the New Testament for Teens (& Adults)

This talk will provide an overview for the significant events of Christianity in the first century A.D., including the birth, ministry and resurrection of Jesus Christ, some of his key teachings, the early Church, Paul the Apostle's role in building it, and some brief comments on the book of Revelation, which closes the first century. There will be a PowerPoint presentation with maps, photographs of key sites, and artwork to record the milestones of this modest Movement that eventually overtook the greatest Empire of ancient history. Questions are welcome and we hope you can join us for this fun and fast overview. A handout will be provided for your notes and later review. And do bring your Bible!

The Gospel of Mark

Believed to have been the first Gospel written, this talk explores Mark's telling of the Jesus story, the arrival of the Kingdom of Heaven, the resistance Christ Jesus experienced, and the relentless march towards the trial, crucifixion, and resurrection. Here we meet the disciples in ways the other Gospels don't reveal, and Jesus' own comments that have little of the softening of later gospels. We will move through the Gospel in the order of its chapters, seeing how the ministry breaks into two parts and the key themes in each. Please bring your Bible as we examine key passages. There will also be a PowerPoint presentation with slides of maps, artwork and key ideas, and a handout will be provided.

Madelon Maupin has a Masters in Theological Studies from San Francisco Theological Seminary and a B.A. in Religion from Principia College. She has lectured for Princess Cruises for their Holy Land tours and has led her own groups to the Middle East, including Israel and Turkey.
